- Major Water Department Project in Bustleton: Because of poor weather, the PWD has moved the start date of the year and a half long project back to January 24. Water mains are being replaced due to their age and material. A daily, on-site PWD Inspector will be working closely with neighbors to help with any road closures or scheduled water shut-offs. The streets being affected: Bloomfield, Verree, Millwood, Alicia, Bridle, Marchman, Ferndale and Stelwood. A PWD representative will give a presentation on the project at our January 24 monthly meeting. An updated Project Summary Sheet will be distributed at the meeting which will give you a good overview of where and why the project is being done, as well as some FAQs.
