Updates:

1. **Bustleton Bengals** – Kevin Hughes honored with a dedicated field.
2. **Police Community Relations Officer, Joe Staszak**
3. **Police Service Area 2 (PSA-2) Meeting** – Mon. November 12, Randi's Rest., 7 pm.
4. **Speed-Cameras Likely Coming to Roosevelt Blvd.** – PA Senate voted to approve the use in a pilot program on the Boulevard that could be active in four to six months. Motorist photographed traveling 11 mph over the 45-mph limit would be awarded a \$150 fine. PA would be the 16th state to adopt a speed-camera program.
5. **Budd Plant/Red Lion Rd Development**–No info yet from city or state officials. Community preparation meeting being planned. Date to be announced.
6. **1840 R Grant Ave. - Possesses Valid License** – Zoning presentation at September meeting from a Bodyshop sought a variance for vehicle paint finishing shop. Ending vote was in support of the variance. As it turns out, the GBCL confirmed that a valid license did exist, and that a new variance wasn't needed for the paint finishing use.

7. **1136 Medway** – Variance request is to legalize an existing side-yard deck, which is prohibited in the RSA-2 Zoning District.
8. **1922 Kohl St.** – Variance request is for the erection of a two-family dwelling, detached structure with two front yard, surface parking spaces, both of which are prohibited in RSD-3 Zoning District.
