

BY-LAWS OF THE GREATER BUSTLETON CIVIC LEAGUE

ARTICLE I

PREAMBLE

- Section A. This organization shall be known as the GREATER BUSTLETON CIVIC LEAGUE.
- Section B. The organization's year shall coincide with the calendar year.
- Section C. The area of the City of Philadelphia known as BUSTLETON shall constitute the following:

"Beginning at the intersection of County Line on the West and Red Lion Road on the North, thence extending Eastwardly along Red Lion Road to Academy Road, thence Southwardly to Grant Avenue, thence Westwardly to Ashton Road, thence Southwardly to the Holme Circle and Southwestwardly on Holme Avenue to the Pennypack Circle of Roosevelt Boulevard, thence Northwardly along Roosevelt Boulevard to Strahle Street, thence Westwardly to Pine Road, and thence Northwardly along Pine Road to Red Lion Road, except area covered by Pennypack Park and Birdwood Farms and area covered by tradition of the League of people living North of Red Lion Road.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE

- Section A. The Greater Bustleton Civic League is formed for the purpose and as a means of discussion of concerns of the members with reference to:  
Proper zoning, adherence to building codes and restrictions, adequate school and recreational facilities, good transportation, community free religious worship, instructing its members in matters pertaining to their benefits as City, State and Federal taxpayers, and all other matters pertaining to Civic Welfare.
- Section B. The policies of this organization shall be non-commercial, non-sectarian and non-partisan.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

- Section A. Any person 18 years of age or older, a resident of the Community outlined in ARTICLE I, Section C, and having a sincere interest in the future of the Community, may join this organization.

ARTICLE IV

DUES

- Section A. The annual dues shall be set by the Executive Board.
- Section B. Should any member feel so inclined, he may withdraw his membership but no refund of dues shall be made.
