 - Toys For Tots, U.S. Marine Corps Reserve Until December 17th drop off <u>New</u> and <u>Unwrapped</u> toys.
- Holiday Fire Awareness & Prevention
 - 51% of December home decoration fires were started by <u>candles</u>.
 Try to use only flame-retardant or not flammable.
 - o Never leave a burning candle unattended.
 - o **Cooking** is the biggest cause of fires and injuries in homes.
 - o Check **holiday lights** each year for frayed wires or wear.
 - Keep <u>Christmas tree</u> away from heat sources and room exits.
 - o Water Christmas trees daily.
 - o Test your **smoke detectors**. Replace if more than 10 years old.

UPS Warehouse proposed for 1 Red Lion Road



- o ZBA <u>DENIED all Appeals</u> from October 12th ZBA Hearing.
- o GBCL and Sandmeyer Steel both <u>appealed</u> ZBA decision. Probable next step is a hearing in <u>Common Pleas Court</u>.
- o <u>UPS ads in NE Times</u>. Listed endorsements misleading:
 - James Donnelly of 58th Ward, knew nothing about ad.
 - NE Chamber of Commerce President: "The quote was not a Chamber endorsement of the specific project."
 - <u>Senator Tartaglione's</u> office: "The Senator said that she does not have a position on the UPS warehouse because the facility is not in her district."

Call To Our Politicians
