

 - GBCL coordinated a community update on March 23rd.
 - Current two car lanes will be reduced to one lane, in each direction.
 - Area residents expressed a desire to extend the lane reduction up Grant Ave. and is now being considered.
 - Project will begin with repaving, tentatively by mid-summer.
 - The GBCL has formally requested the creation of bike lanes be included in the project.
