For the past four years, the Bustleton / Somerton / Lower Moreland communities have worked to stop the damage this project would inflict.

This is the biggest threat our community has ever encountered in the GBCL's 70-year existence.

The GBCL and Sandmeyer Lane businesses continue their appeals of the zoning and building permits granted for the project. Both groups are appealing Philadelphia Common Pleas Court case denials with the PA Commonwealth Courts.
