



In light of the recent tragedy, and the fact that many flights fly over the Bustleton community, the GBCL reached out to PHL / PNE management to learn more about the PNE operation.

Northeast Philadelphia Airport:

- PNE is Pennsylvania's third busiest airport.
- Air traffic is managed by the <u>Federal Aviation</u>
 <u>Administration</u> (FAA), which does operate a control tower at Northeast Philadelphia Airport.
- While there has been an increase in air traffic from 2004-2024, we <u>cannot speculate on air traffic</u> growth at PNE.
- There were an average of <u>335 flight operations a</u> <u>day</u> at PNE in 2024.(125 itinerant and 210 local flight operations per day).
- PNE has voluntary program in an effort to limit touch-and-go flight operations and associated noise.
 - Mondays through Saturdays between the hours of 09:00 AM and 10:00 PM and Sundays between 12:00 PM and 10:00 PM limit of five touch-and-goes per flight.
 - Mondays through Saturdays between the hours of 10:00 PM and 09:00 AM and Sundays between 10:00PM and 12:00 PM pilots are asked not to conduct touch-and-goes.
- During nighttime hours all aircraft use a common traffic advisory radio frequency to broadcast their location and position. Spacing is maintained primarily using visual flight rules (VFR) when weather conditions allow.



Proposed UPS Warehouse - 1 Red Lion Rd.



The proposed UPS warehouse is the most damaging development our community has ever faced and the worst disregard for its impact the GBCL has ever experienced.

The basis for the community's opposition has never been evaluated in court. Our zoning appeal has been dismissed by the ZBA, Philadelphia Common Pleas Court, PA Commonwealth Court, and now waits for a decision with the PA Supreme Court to allow us our "due process". The silence and lack of involvement by our elected officials is deafening.

Our community OPPOSESES the SIZE of the massive project and the impact truck traffic will have on our community.

4,798 vehicles will be added to the road each day, of which 1,048 of those vehicles will be large tractor-trailers.

UPS Warehouse Legal Status

GBCL is involved in two (2) ongoing proceedings.

1. Zoning Appeal in PA Court.

Our Appeal working through the Courts is <u>not</u> a
 determination on the underlying <u>zoning issues</u>. Our
 Appeal is a <u>request to receive "due process"</u> and
 allow us to put on a full case to validate our
 position, with witnesses, which has yet to happen.

2. <u>UPS developer is Suing the GBCL and its Officers.</u>

- Relteva Complaint: "GBCL and Sandmeyer have <u>submitted frivolous appeals</u> of both the zoning and building permits lawfully issued to Relteva that have absolutely no legal merit and which were submitted solely for the purpose of <u>delay</u>, <u>harassment</u> and thwarting the development of the Property."
- GBCL believes UPS developer lawsuit is without merit and is aggressively defending against it.
